The Ellen Woodnick Mitzvah Mall is run by our **4th grade Hebrew School students and families**. This project is intended to help promote *G'milut Chasadim* (acts of loving kindness) and to provide a meaningful gift giving alternative.

The Mitzvah Mall is a fair of non-profit organizations that promotes charitable giving in a simple and educational setting. It is similar to a vendor fair. Every student in our school and many temple congregants come to the Mitzvah Mall to “shop” among the charities that are represented at different stations. At each station, donations for a particular charity may be “purchased” in amounts ranging from \$1 to \$18 in exchange for a certificate stating how the donated money will be used by that organization.

- **STEP 1: Talk with your child(ren) about whom they would like to honor this holiday season (teachers, grandparents, etc.)**
- **STEP 2: Go through this packet and see which “gifts” you would like to purchase in exchange for donation certificates.**
- **STEP 3: Fill out the shopping list with your child(ren). Checks are to be made payable to Temple Chai.**
- **STEP 4: On December 10th, join your child(ren) at the Mall with their class to make their purchases.**

Please send each student with his/her own list and cash/check.

Students will visit the Mall by class so they will not be able to shop and share money with a sibling in another grade.

The Mitzvah Mall is open to everyone! We welcome parents and community members to come shop on the 10th!
